TAXES

- A. Resolution No. 08-1067 expressing support of the renewal of the County one-quarter cent retailers' sales tax to be used for public safety programs was considered.

Councilmember Montgomery stated he was in support of the renewal as long as the monies are used for public safety.

Councilmember Bacon stated he was against not having a sunset to the tax, but would be in favor if the monies were in support of the schools. Mr. Bacon further stated he will vote against expressing support of the renewal.


